This En Plein Air event will begin at the Millikin Homestead at 2 PM October 19 with a Demonstration by an artist. The details for the contest will be handed out and questions answered at that time.

Contestants can choose any media for paintings. Painting media will be Marked at the start date of the 19th. You will have all week to complete your work. Pictures need to be able to be hung. They will be submitted Oct. 25( Saturday)at Madden Art Center(3<sup>rd</sup> fl) at 2 pm. Judging will take place at that time.

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup>--\$100; 2<sup>nd</sup>--\$75; 3<sup>rd</sup>--\$50 ( or proportioned from the entry fees, if less than \$300)

### PLEIN AIR RULES

## "PAINT/PHOTO MACON COUNTY FALL COLOR"

OCT. 19—OCT. 24, 2025

- All entries must be painted during the week of Oct. 19-Oct. 24
- Participants must be at least 18 yo.
- Bring your medium paper or whatever you will be painting on for "entry Mark" to Millikin Homestead at 2 pm Sunday Oct. 19. (if you can't be there for the 19<sup>th</sup>, bring your medium surface to the Sessions Oct. 8 or 15)
- Artists will supply their own materials. All mediums are allowed.
- Only sites within Macon County are allowed.
- Entry size can be up to 250 sq. in. plus framing; e.g., 14X17=238.
- Strive for at least 50% of the painting being done at the site.
- Art works need to be ready to hang with wire for the critique and judging. (Hanging will be at 1 pm on Oct. 24 at Madden Art Center (3<sup>rd</sup> floor))—125 N. Water St., Decatur. Judging will be at 2 pm.
- Tag on entry: Name of piece, location, day, medium, artist, artist experience (Beginner, amateur, experienced). Please include a photo of your site. You may submit up to two pieces.
- All pieces need to be removed at the end of the day, Oct. 24.
- For safety of artists, they are urged to paint with partners or a group. This is also to encourage fellowship among the artists.
- A short note (100 words or less) of what attracted you to paint the piece would be nice, but not required.
- If the proceeds for this event aren't sufficient to award the stated prizes, the monies will be awarded on a percentage basis. Money in excess of the prize and Judge fee will be added to the treasury.
- By entering this event participants agree to maintain ethical behavior and integrity.
- We do not carry insurance for this event.
